

We welcome all gifts in wills, however large or small. We aim to use gifts to help fund significant specific expenditure in the life of the parish, whether on buildings, equipment, furnishings or staff.

Since needs change over the years, we encourage donors to leave a gift in their will for the general purposes of the parish rather than for a restricted purpose. We will discuss possible uses of the gift with executors when the time comes, and will aim to bear in mind the donor's known areas of interest in the church (e.g. music, buildings, children and youth, mission or aid) and the church's priorities at the time.

Donors can be confident that their gift will be used to make a real difference to our future mission and ministry. We will acknowledge gifts in whatever way the donor and/or his/her executors feel most appropriate, but can also allow the gift to remain anonymous if the donor prefers.

If donors or executors wish to speak in confidence about the sorts of purposes their gift might fund and how/if they would like their gift to be acknowledged, they should contact the Rector or one of the churchwardens.
